COURSE DESCRIPTION

Rigging and Lifting Module is a comprehensive videotape and text training program. It teaches the procedures for using: hand-operated chain hoists, overhead traveling cranes, forklifts, mobile cranes, scaffolding, and ladders. The program shows the various maintenance activities being performed on actual plant equipment. Videotape 1 includes hand-operated hoists, planning and equipment selection, hoist inspection, shackle and trolley inspection, etc. Videotape 2 includes introduction to overhead traveling cranes, performing an operational inspection on an overhead traveling crane, using a spreader bar, etc. Videotape 3 includes inspecting a mobile crane, test driving a mobile crane, static and operational inspection of a forklift, removing a pallet from a truck, etc. Videotape 4 includes components of ladders and ladder selection, climbing and lowering an extension ladder, erecting a fixed scaffold, etc.
